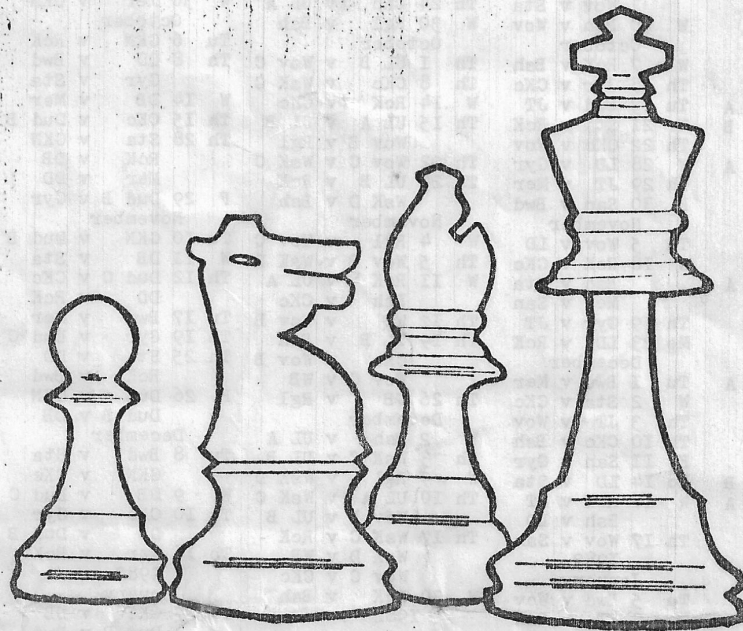

OBITUARY

PETER JACKSON

The sudden death of Peter on September 15th came as a great shock to all who knew him. He had been a friend and colleague of mine at County level for over 20 years, and had played a major role in the affairs of the County during that time, holding the post of Treasurer for 9 years and Secretary for 10 years, giving the latter up in 1980. He also held the post of 1st team Vice Captain and 2nd team Captain during this time and played for both, another post he held for many years was Secretary of his club Stafford. Peter played a great deal of correspondence chess, much of it at International level. His library of Chess books were many and Peter put them to good use for he won many more games than he lost or drew. Most of Peter's over the board chess was played in the Wolverhampton League and he was given the honour of being made League President in 1974. His other interests included Philately, Mathematics, Cricket, Photography and Badminton. He had been playing the latter when he died. One of Peter's disappointments was not being able to form a County League, in fact 2 days before his passing he had been at a County Committee meeting were this was one of the items mentioned. It would be a very fitting tribute to Peter if one could be brought into being, and a cup given in his name.

Peter will be missed by all who knew him in the Chess world and by all who knew him in his many other interests, and may I offer, on behalf of them all, and myself the deepest condolences to his widow and family in their sad bereavement.

Division I Fixture Dates

I have been having a closer look at the fixtures made at
the fixture meeting and I am not very pleased with what
I have found. Out of 55 matches to be played in Div. I,
23 have been arranged outside the periods given by me,
of the 23 matches, 14 concern 4 clubs, each fixing 7
matches outside the dates given. 11 of the 23 have been
arranged after March 12th, the date by which all matches
should be started.

I am well aware that the clubs concerned play in another
League, but their problems should not be mine. Four
other clubs in Div. I play in another league and arranged
their fixtures within the period given, so there is no
excuse for those who have not complied with the rules.
Clubs are not allowed to fix their matches outside the
period given in the Birmingham League so why should they
do so in this League.

The four teams have a lopsided set of fixtures. Walsall
'B' have only 3 matches before Xmas, and no match in the
12 weeks period Oct. 22-Jan. 14. Bushbury have only 3
matches before Xmas and no match in 7 weeks period Oct.
28-Dec. 17.

It is not right for clubs to arrange fixtures several
weeks out of the time given by the fixture secretary,
or to arrange any matches in April. This seems to imply
that for me to draw up a set of fixtures is a waste of my
time.
